Dany's Iglésia Renacer (Rebirth) held clinics in a nearby library, loaned free! Besides serving 160 neighbors, we witnessed Holy Spirit draw teacher-librarian Ricardo to a saving faith! Noé's church, *Iglésia Vida*, rented an adjacent event center to bless 240 more patients. Many expressed surprise that our services were *gratis*, naturally leading us to share about grace and the free gift of faith in Christ for salvation.

Repeat servant to medical missions, sonographer Victoria Goulet scanned 90 patients, allowing pregnant women to see their babies, confirming medical diagnoses or saying, "All is normal!" to bring relief. Victoria also recruited her
